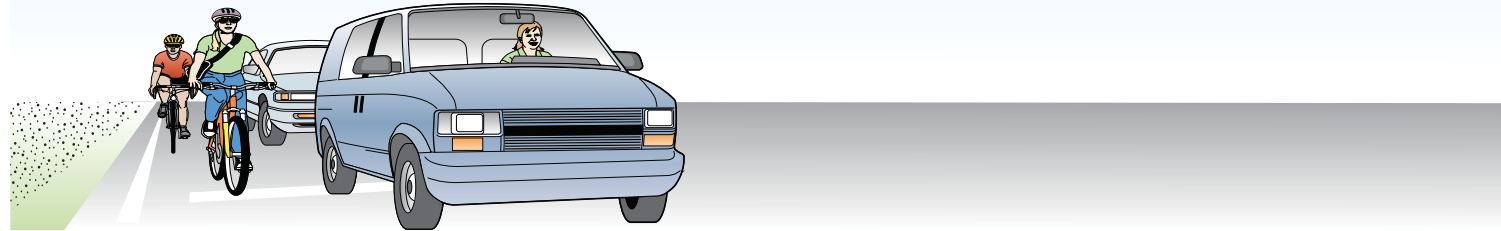


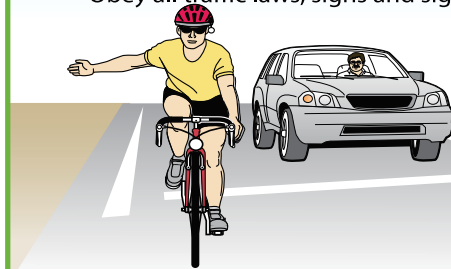
Sharing the Road Safely

turning right turning left slowing down

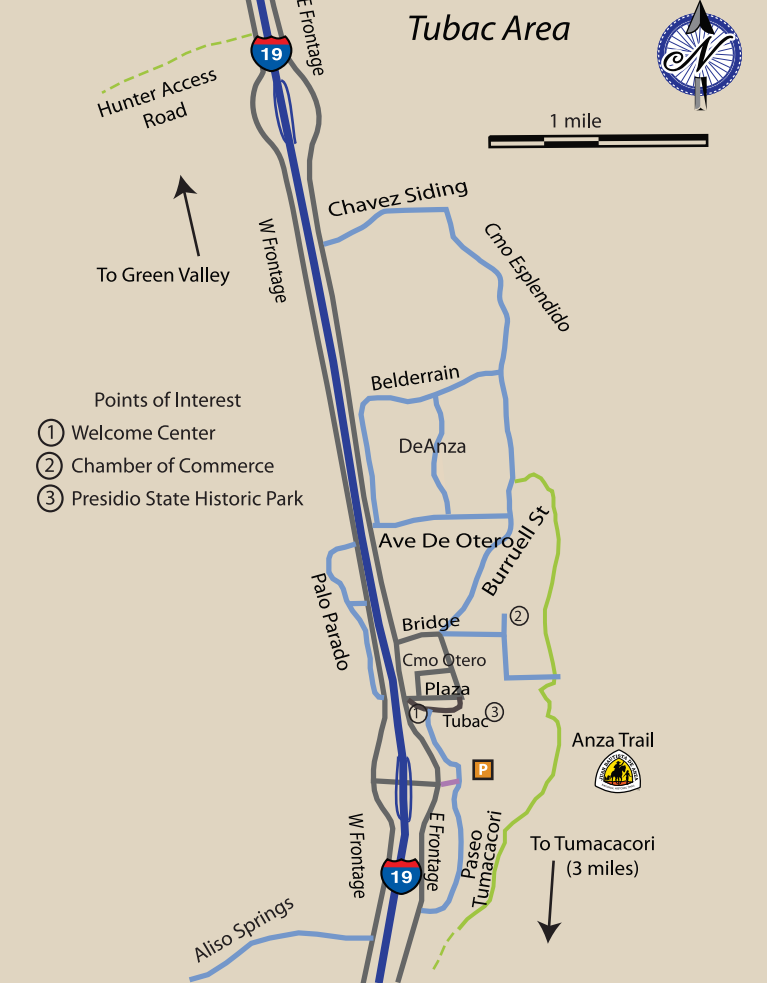
SANTA CRUZ VALLEY BIKE MAP

Green Valley - Sahuarita and Surrounding Areas



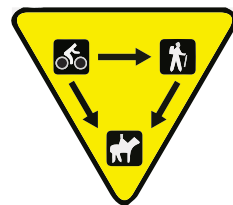

IMBA Rules of the Trail

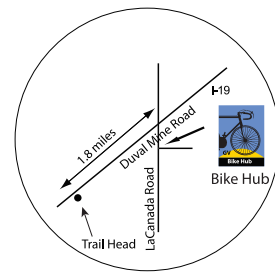
1. Ride Open Trails

6. Plan Ahead



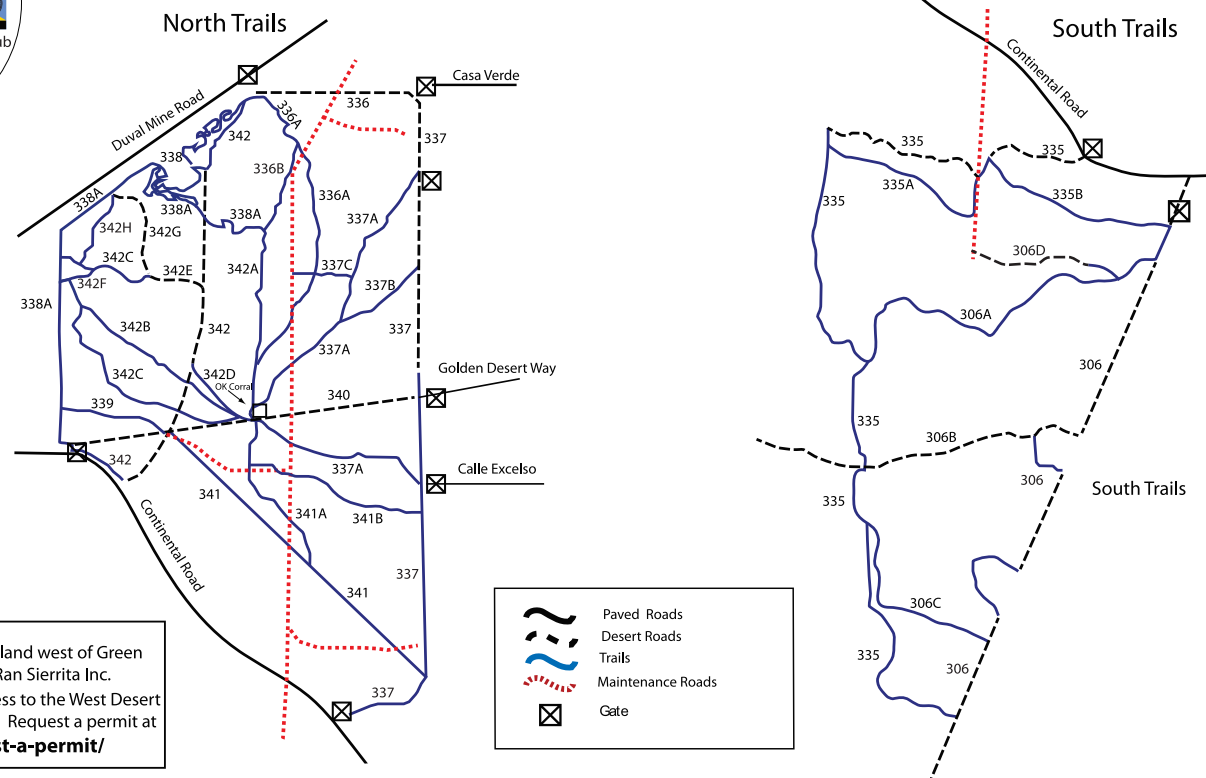
